WE SHALL REMAIN: America Through Native Eyes Episode 1: After the Mayflower (90 minutes)

After the Mayflower, is a PBS documentary that begins in the 1620s, at the time of the "first Thanksgiving."

Massasoit, chief of the Wampanoag in Massachusetts, gambled and negotiated a diplomatic alliance with a scraggly band of English settlers resulting in several decades of relative peace. However, a half-century later, the alliance was broken.

This episode tells a story of Native-Americans who initially pursued peace, fought to keep their land from being confiscation and struggled to keep their culture from being dismantled.
