Marilyn Elie has worked to close Indian Point for the last 17 years. She got involved because of the unsolvable problem of high-level radioactive waste, a toxic legacy from us to future generations. As a leader and organizer, she learned to watch-dog the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, reading NRC reports for what is hidden between the lines. She has regularly attended their meetings while the agency has changed under three regional directors. On occasion she is the only person at NRC meetings who can attest to changes in their regulatory position because she has been there since the original meeting. Marilyn Elie can tell us a lot about what a citizen can do, and how our government is working in this dangerous arena.
